

Wastewater and Stormwater Maintenance Program

Veolia Water Network Services, is doing maintenance work on Sydney Water's wastewater and stormwater systems. This work is part of a five year maintenance program to improve the wastewater and stormwater systems and protect public health and the environment.

Work involves both proactive and reactive activities, such as:

- inspecting and cleaning stormwater quality improvement devices and stormwater trash racks, channels, canals and sediment basins
- cleaning wastewater grit pits and dredging wastewater mains to remove silt
- removing and disposing of liquid waste (including clearing of wastewater chokes and overflows).

The work will be done on a when required basis using highly specialised equipment such as combination units, drain cleaners, water recycling combination units, vacuum trucks and backhoes.

During the work residents and businesses may notice an increase in vehicle movements, noise and odour. Sydney Water and Veolia Water Network Services will make every effort to minimise these impacts. This work will not cause interruption to your sewer or water services.

Working hours will be 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays, as required. However, some night work may be required in areas not easily accessible during the day.
